Previous minutes:

From the AGM – Amendment to the constitution (14.5) to reflect that not all players will be eligible for matchplay under new system. The top 8 players (from each grade) of the championships results will contest matchplay – 1 v 8, 2 v 7, 3 v 6 and 4 v 5. Any of the top 8 that cannot compete will be replaced with the 9th placed finisher and so on.

Fees for the 2025 season will be increased to \$1000 as voted in by a majority vote at the AGM.
